California Law and California Dental Board regulations requires that a dentist has received a general anesthesia permit issued by the California Dental Board, when general anesthesia is administered by a dentist or a CRNA in a dental office.

California Law and California Dental Board regulations requires that a dentist has received a general anesthesia permit or a conscious anesthesia permit when conscious sedation is administered by a dentist or a CRNA in a dental office.

Neither California law or California Dental Board regulations require a dentist to have a general anesthesia permit or a conscious sedation permit when anesthesia services are provided by a CRNA in an accredited surgery center or a hospital.
