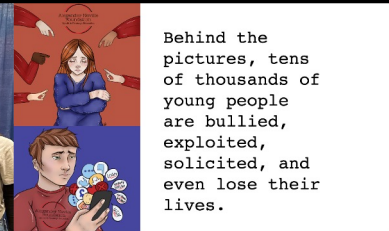

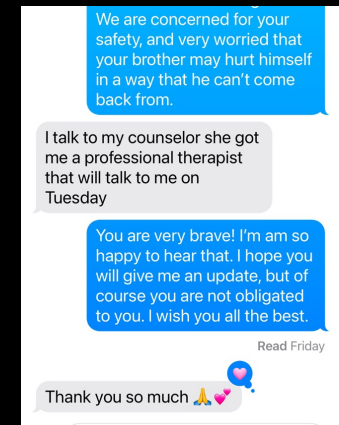
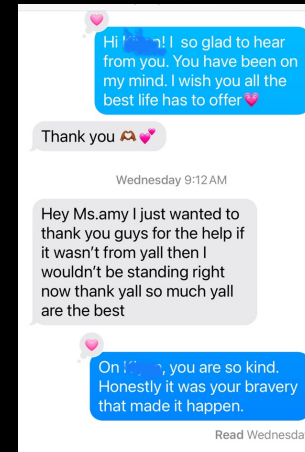

Helped several teen in crisis

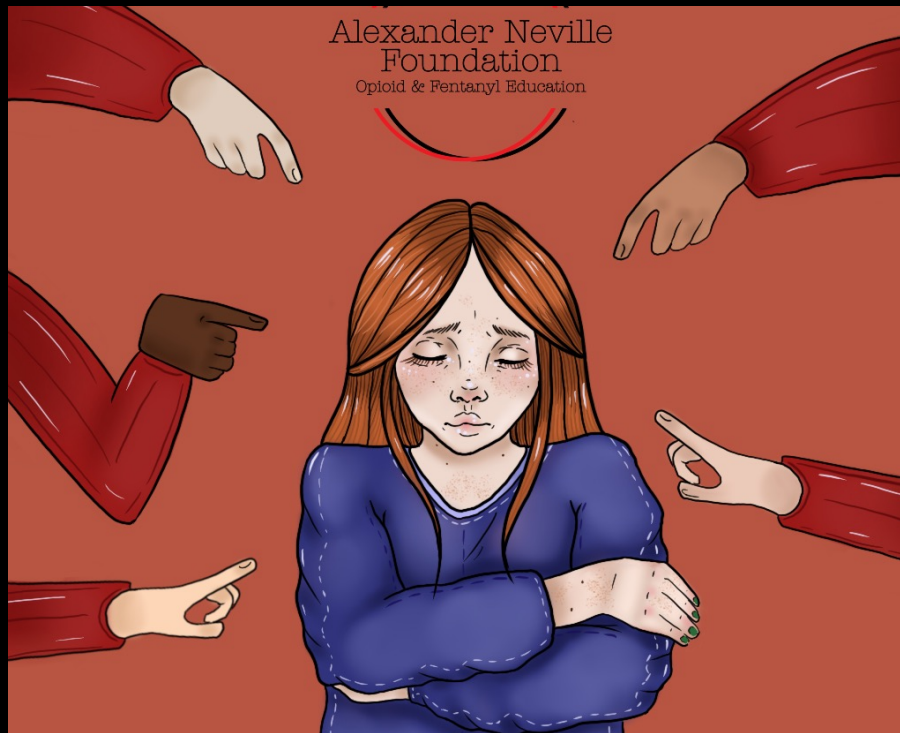


# What Teens want you to know

## AMY NEVILLE, , ET AL. VS SNAP, INC.

### Case Summary

On October 13, 2022, **Amy Neville, Aaron Neville, Jaime Puerta, Mariam Hernandez, Cindy Cruz-Sarantos, Bridgette Norring, James Mccarthy, Kathleen Mccarthy, Samantha Mccarthy, Matthew Capelouto**, and others (collectively, “Plaintiffs”), represented by Laura M. Garrett of Social Media Victims Law Center and Hannah Meropol of C. A. Goldberg, PLLC, filed a **civil lawsuit** against **Snap, Inc.** (“Defendant”), seeking declaratory relief and damages for alleged personal injury. This case was filed in the [Los Angeles County Superior Court of California](#), with Judges Lawrence P. Riff and David S. Cunningham III presiding.

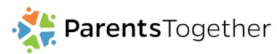
